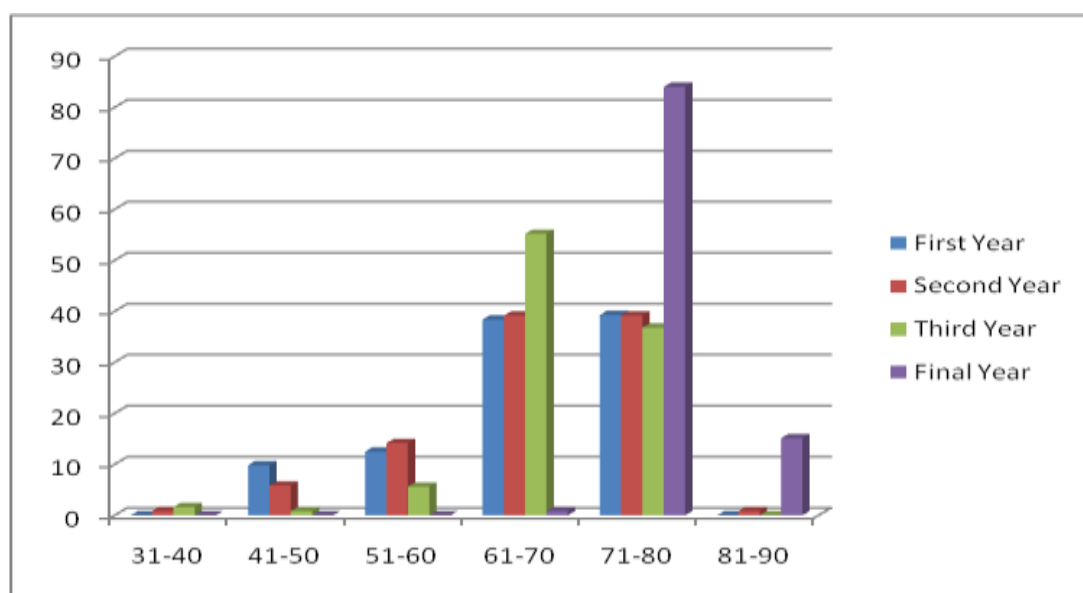

Performance of Students in the Academic Year 2022-23

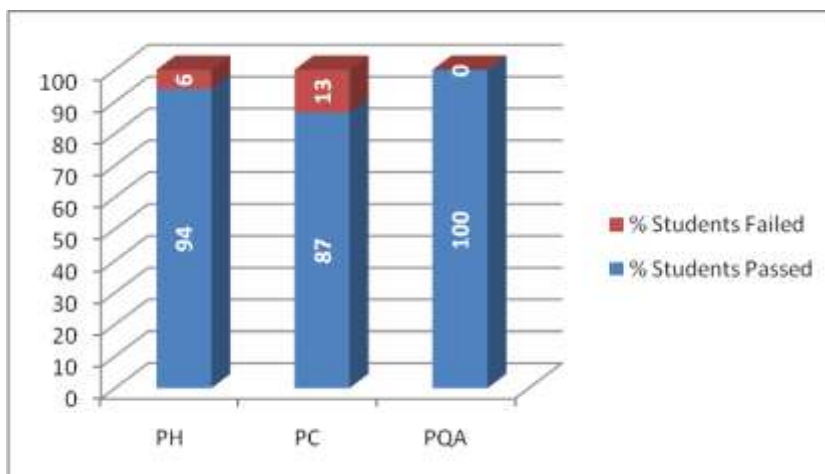

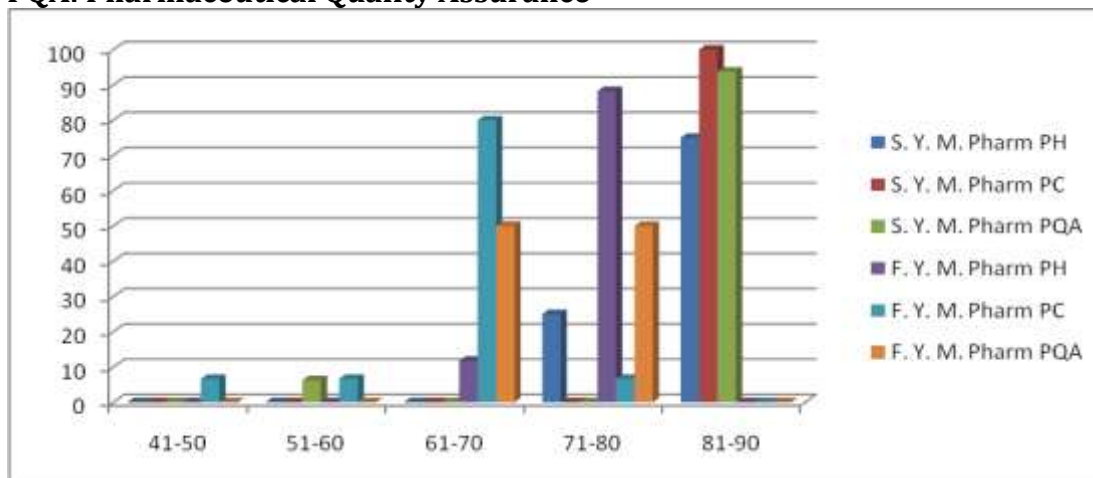
